The best method depends upon severity. For light mishaps, an enzymatic pre-spray and extensive rinse might do it. 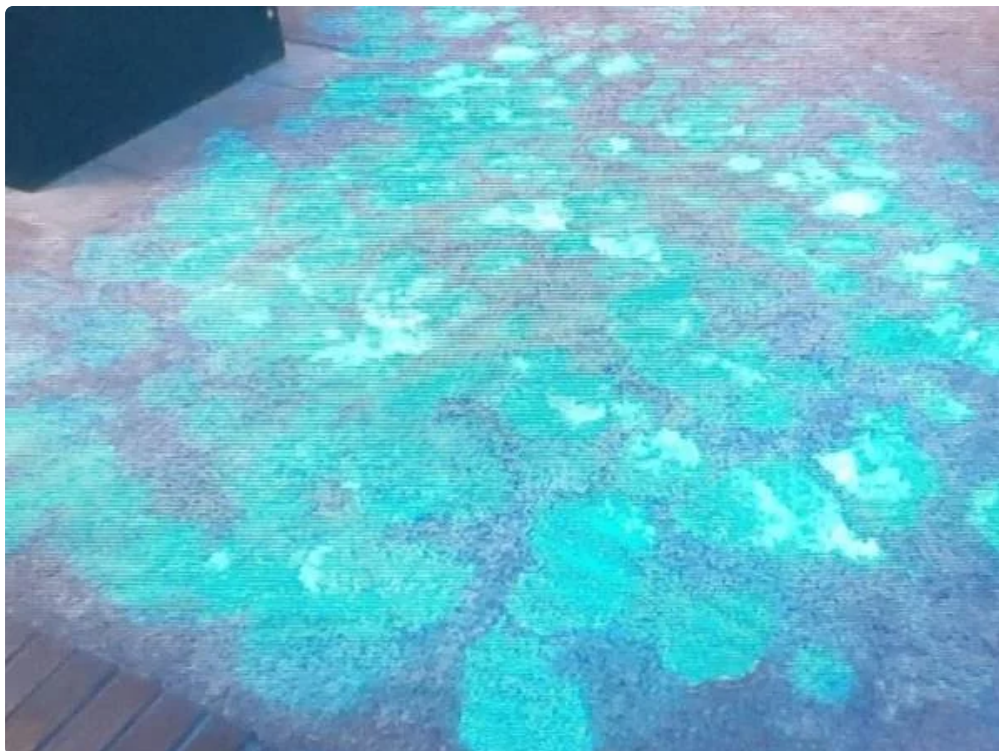
