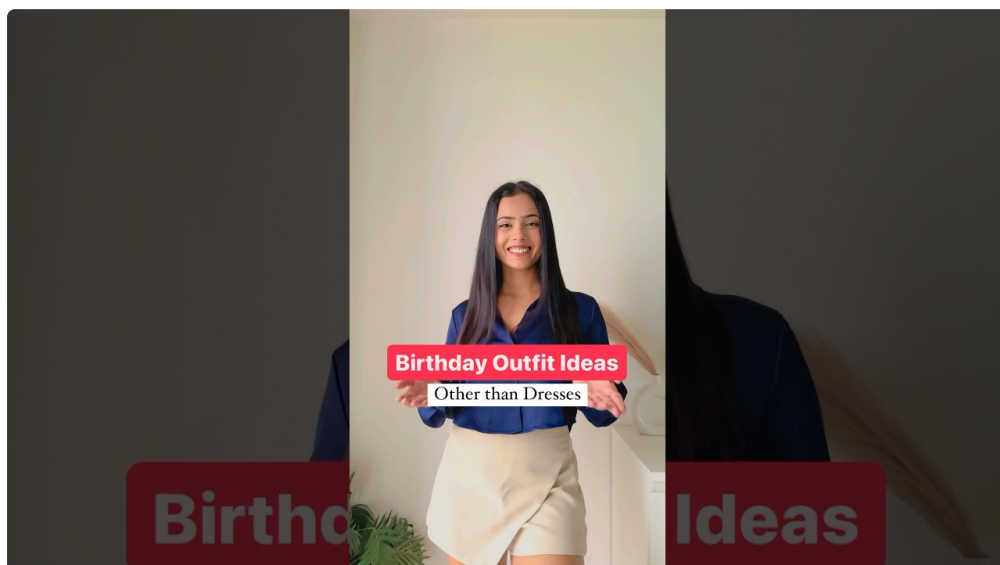
The shift from organizing for a young kid to coordinating for a teen means recognizing changed needs and adjusting your methods [birthday planner](#) appropriately.
