Understanding the Wheel Segments and Bets

To play Crazy Time effectively, players need to initially comprehend the wagering layout. The 54 sectors on the wheel are divided into number bets and bonus offer game bets. Each segment uses various payment potentials and possibilities.

Number Bets

- **1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel. Payout: 1:1
- **2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel. Payment: 2:1
- **5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel. Payout: 5:1
- **10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel. Payout: 10:1

Perk Game Bets

- **Coin Flip:** Appears 4 times on the wheel.

- **Cash Hunt:** Appears 2 times on the wheel.
- **Pachinko:** Appears 2 times on the wheel.
- **Crazy Time:** Appears 1 time on the wheel.

The Top Slot Feature

Before every spin of the primary wheel, a tiny two-reel fruit machine located above the primary wheel spins concurrently.

- **How it Works:** The left reel displays among the wagering options (numbers or bonus offer video games), while the ideal reel shows a multiplier (varying from 2x up to 50x).
- **The Result:** If the symbol on the left reel matches the result of the main wheel spin, the multiplier is applied to that win. If it indicates a perk video game, the multiplier applies to all multipliers inside that particular perk round.

Diving Into the Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

1. Coin Flip

- **Bonus feature:** If multipliers are low, a "Rescue Flip" can sometimes be set off, providing players another opportunity at greater rewards.

2. Money Hunt

Gamers exist with a huge interactive screen showing a shooting gallery with 108 random multipliers concealed behind different signs (like a cactus, target, or sheriff's badge).

- **The Gameplay:** Players use a virtual cannon to aim and contend one symbol before a countdown timer expires. As soon as the timer ends, all signs reveal their hidden multipliers, and the gamer is awarded the multiplier they hit.

3. Pachinko

Motivated by the standard Japanese arcade video game, Pachinko includes a big wall filled with physical pegs.

- **The Gameplay:** The live host drops a puck from the top of the wall. As the puck cascades downward, it bounces arbitrarily off the pegs before landing in one of numerous multiplier zones at the bottom. If the puck arrive at a "DOUBLE" zone, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again.

4. Crazy Time

The supreme reward round. Players stroll through a red door into a surreal, virtual world including a huge, 64-segment mega [crazy time demo](#) wheel.

- **The Gameplay:** The gamer (or the host, depending on the video game variation) picks one of three flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel is spun, and whatever multiplier the chosen flapper indicate is awarded. Like Pachinko, this wheel likewise includes "DOUBLE" and "TRIPLE" segments, allowing lucky players to activate astronomical wins up to the video game's cap of 20,000 x.

Tips and Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is essentially a video game of chance determined by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and physical physics, gamers frequently use different methods to handle their bankroll and optimize entertainment.



- **The Conservative Approach (Number Betting):**
 - Focus mostly on wagering numbers 1 and 2, that make up a large part of the wheel. This method yields frequent, smaller wins, keeping the bankroll stable and extending playtime.
- **The Balanced Approach (Covering Bonuses):**
 - Spread little bets across all 4 benefit rounds while occasionally backing number 10. This makes sure eligibility for the high-paying bonus video games without draining funds too rapidly.
- **The High-Volatility Approach (Bonus Hunting):**
 - Place bets specifically on the reward rounds (Cash Hunt, Pachinko, Crazy Time, Coin Flip). This style requires perseverance and a bigger bankroll, as droughts can happen, but it provides direct access to the game's greatest possible payments.

Finest Practices for Responsible Gaming

1. **Set a Budget:** Decide on a fixed quantity to spend before starting the video game and never chase losses.
2. **Understand the RTP:** Keep in mind that perk bets normally have a somewhat lower RTP than basic number bets, meaning they are higher risk, greater reward.
3. **Take pleasure in the Show:** Treat the wagering cost as the cost of admission to an interactive video game show. The primary goal needs to constantly be entertainment.
