Many gamers question what their real possibilities are of pulling an unusual item. Valve does not formally publish the exact percentages for every single item, however through millions of community-tracked case openings, the statistical possibilities have ended up being widely accepted.

Approximated CS2 Case Drop Probabilities

- **Blue (Mil-Spec):** ~ 79.92%
- **Purple (Restricted):** ~ 15.98%
- **Pink (Classified):** ~ 3.20%
- **Red (Covert):** ~ 0.64%
- **Special Rare (Knives/ Gloves):** ~ 0.26%

*Note: Within each tier, there is an extra 10% possibility to receive a **StatTrak**™ version, which tracks the variety of kills made with that weapon.*

4. Popular CS2 Cases to Watch
