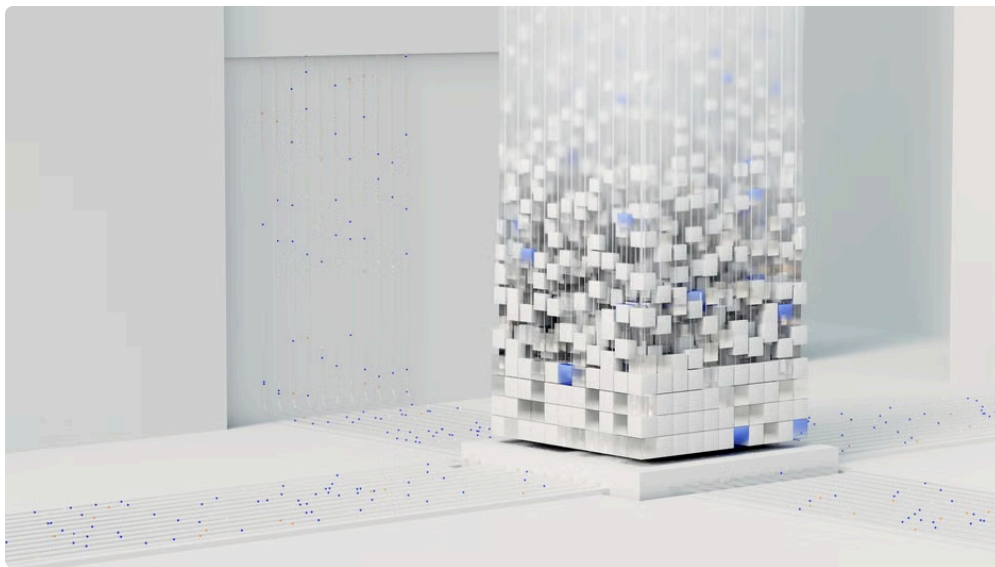
Cost Advantage: Consolidating Many Tools into One Subscription

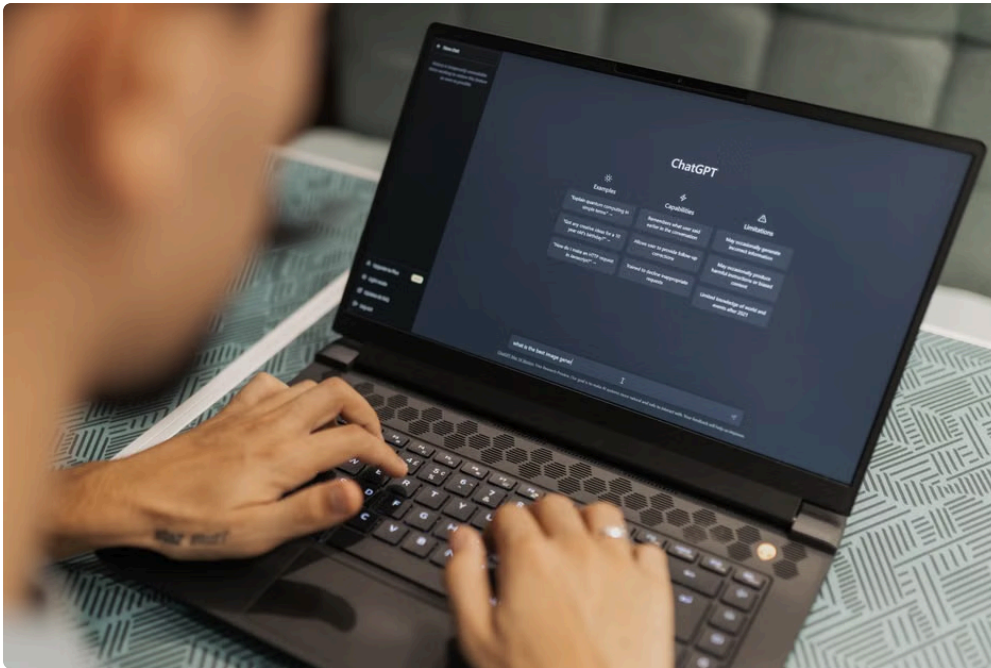
Conclusion: Does Suprmind Scribe Actually Take Meeting Minutes?
