Pair of eights Any Split
Pair of 10s Any Stand (Never Split)

2. Master Bankroll Management

Gamers need to approach every session with a clear, predefined spending plan.

- **Set a Loss Limit:** Decide ahead of time how much cash is appropriate to lose in a single session, and walk away right away if that limit is reached.

As shown in the table, side bets and insurance coverage bets greatly favor the gambling establishment. For players focused on optimizing their long-term chances of winning, these optional wagers are best ignored totally.

4. Understand Table Rules Before You Sit
