Note: Exact probabilities vary slightly depending upon the specific house edge (usually set between 1% and 5%) constructed into the platform's algorithm.

1. The Martingale Strategy

- **The Risk:** Requires a huge bankroll and can quickly strike table limits or lack funds during a long losing streak (e.g., numerous consecutive 1.00 x crashes).

2. The Reverse Martingale (Paroli)
