Branded apparel is always a popular choice, but only if it is high quality and something people would actually wear. Instead of a low-cost, badly fitting t-shirt, consider a superior-quality polo shirt, a stylish cap, a cozy scarf, or a practical jacket. These garments are more inclined to be worn and therefore more likely to promote your brand.



Tech Accessories

Technology accessories are invariably valued by contemporary attendees. Think about a portable phone charger, a USB stick pre-loaded with conference materials, a wireless mouse, or a laptop sleeve. These items are practical, useful, and likely to [Kollysphere](#) be used well after the gathering.

A Sense of Place
