Is the 30% solar tax credit going away in 2026 in Sacramento?

Yes, the federal 30% Residential Clean Energy Credit ended for residential expenditures made after December 31, 2025. Unused eligible credits from earlier years may still be carried forward under applicable tax rules. Different provisions may apply to businesses and other ownership structures.
