Start with how you utilize the room

Every dwelling room has its choreography. Maybe you figure from the settee two days a week. Maybe your young people build Lego cities on the espresso desk each and every afternoon. Maybe you host motion picture nights and desire an area for a soundbar, a small amp, and a basket of blankets. Anchoring your layout to the ones routines assists in keeping the shelving purposeful.

I wish to map the room in two passes. First, a birds-eye sketch with measured partitions, windows, radiators, retailers, vents, and the swing of any doors. In a slender rowhouse, we wrapped a window with bookshelves and developed a 17 inch deep window seat over a shallow radiator canopy.
