Solid timber is for frames and edges in which it can cross with out cracking. Face frames in poplar take paint neatly and avert edges crisp. Light, shadow, and the lower back panel decision

The cabinet close to the attitude had a curved scribe to meet the plaster. It took an additional day of careful coping, however the ultimate sweep felt long-established.

In a small house, we saved cupboards shallow at 10.5 inches and skipped doors altogether to circumvent the visible bulk of rails and stiles. Thin cabinets with steel pin helps, complete to suit the wall, gave just enough screen without crowding the loveseat. A surface outlet less than a slender console taken care of a lamp and kept cords off the fireside.

Old properties require humility. Expect walls out of plumb with the aid of half of an inch over eight toes and flooring that dip. This is where scribe moldings and wider stile edges pay. Two projects that taught me whatever new

A domestic in a 1970s ranch sought after up to date strains devoid of losing warmth. We developed flush, full-overlay shelves in rift white oak, horizontal grain matched throughout doorways. The fireplace turned into a overall brick surround. Rather than pores and skin the brick, we ground the mortar flush, cleaned the face, and added a low, 2-inch-thick all rightmantel that covered up with the cabinet tops at 30 inches. LED strips lived in a shallow show under every one shelf. The result felt close to Scandinavian. The lesson changed into restraint. We deleted crown thoroughly and permit a 1/2-inch shadow hole on the ceiling carry the detail. That unmarried disclose did extra work than any molding might.

In a Victorian with 10-foot ceilings, the issue changed into mass. The shopper desired bookcases that felt like they had continually been there. We designed full-top situations with arched tops that echoed pocket door headers, beaded inset doors less than, and a deep mantel bridging the distance. Adjustable cabinets had been 1 inch thick with a hid steel strip below the front side to avert sag. We used a hand-brushed paint end after setting up to blend into the customary plaster quirks. I had to scribe 3/4 inch on one edge opposed to a wall that bellied twice. The assignment took longer than planned, yet when the fuel fireplace lit for the first time, the room exhaled. It belonged.

Working with the top people

If you employ a custom cabinetry contractor, look for the small things. Do they template on site or eyeball? Do they ask what you can store or just quote an elevation?
