

A cracked windshield has a way of turning an ordinary drive into a small expedition. One minute you are rolling down Market Street or cutting across Greensboro with a cup of coffee in the console. The next, a pebble snaps off a truck tire, the glass pops like a cap gun, and a silver star blooms in your line of sight.

That little mark asks a bigger question than most drivers expect: who do you trust with the glass between you and the road?

The BBB listing shows an A+ rating, while also noting that the business is not BBB accredited. That distinction matters. A rating and accreditation are not the same thing. Accreditation is a separate status. An A+ rating is still a strong signal within that listing, but a careful driver should understand what each label means rather than blending them together.

On the review side, Impex Auto Glass shows a 4.9-star rating based on 162 Google reviews as displayed through Birdeye. For a local windshield replacement service, that combination of a high average and a meaningful number of reviews is worth attention. A perfect-looking score from three reviews tells you very little. A 4.9 average from 162 reviews gives you a broader sample of customer experience.

The reviews shown there mention windshield replacement, mobile replacement, fast turnaround, professional staff, and fair or affordable pricing. One review specifically describes a windshield replacement completed in under an hour at the customer's residence. But it does show that mobile service and speed are part of the customer record.

How to read star ratings without getting fooled

A star rating is a trail marker, not the whole map. A 4.9-star rating looks strong, but the real value comes from reading the words behind it.

Start with volume. A rating based on 162 reviews carries more reliability than a rating based on a handful. Then look for recency. A business can change. Staff, scheduling, suppliers, and ownership practices can shift over time.

Reviews from the last few months often give a sharper picture than reviews from several years back.

Next, watch for patterns. One driver may have a strange day. Five drivers mentioning the same strength or weakness deserve more attention. If review after review praises fast turnaround, that suggests the shop may be well organized. A short field checklist before you book

Use reviews to narrow the path, then make a focused call. Five minutes of clear questions can prevent a half-day detour.

1. Ask whether your damage calls for cracked windshield repair, rock chip repair, or full windshield replacement.
2. Confirm whether mobile windshield replacement is available for your location and conditions.
3. Request a written or clearly stated windshield replacement estimate before approving the job.
4. Ask about ADAS windshield calibration if your vehicle has camera-based driver assistance features.
5. Clarify insurance windshield replacement claim steps and your deductible before scheduling.

Red flags worth slowing down for

Not every review profile deserves your confidence. Some patterns should make you pause, ask more questions, or keep searching for the best windshield replacement near me.



Watch out for vague praise that never mentions the actual service. Think of reviews like a compass. They point direction, but they do not walk the trail for you.

A BBB A+ rating is another signal. A Greensboro address and business classification add practical context.
