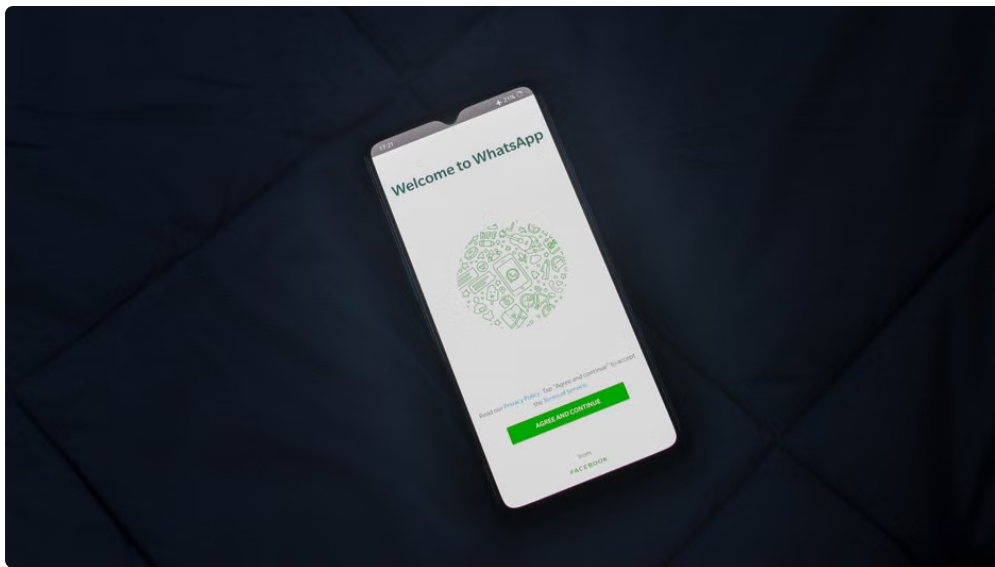
Verified Download Sources and Domain Checks
