

A cracked windshield has a way of turning an ordinary drive into a small expedition. One minute you are rolling down the road with coffee in the cup holder and the radio low. The next, a stone snaps off a truck tire, taps the glass like a slingshot, and leaves a bright little starburst right in your line of sight. Sometimes it stays small. Sometimes it grows overnight, stretching across the windshield like a trail on a map.
