Licensing, bonding, and the quiet value of compliance

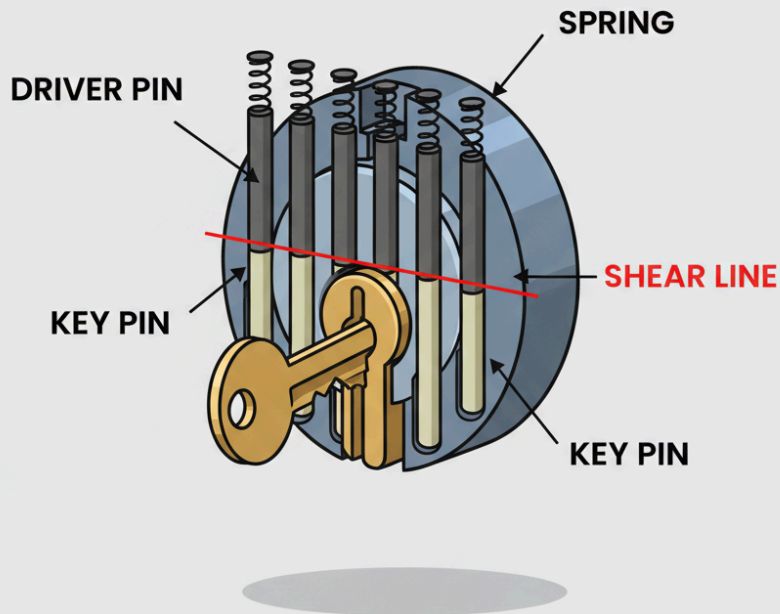
