1. The Conservative Approach (Low Risk)

- **Focus:** Betting mostly on the numbers **1** and **2**.
- **Goal:** To extend playtime and cover a large portion of the wheel (over 65% combined possibility).
- **Pros:** Frequent small wins assist maintain the bankroll.
- **Cons:** Misses out on the high-flying action of the bonus offer rounds.

2. The Bonus Chaser (High Risk/ High Reward)

- **Focus:** Placing little bets exclusively on the 4 bonus segments (**Coin Flip, Cash Hunt, Pachinko, Crazy Time**).
- **Goal:** To strike the perk rounds as frequently as possible, depending on the leading slot multipliers to deliver huge payouts.
- **Pros:** Keeps you eligible for the most exciting and profitable parts of the game.
- **Cons:** High volatility; dry spells can quickly diminish a bankroll if bonuses stop working to land.

3. The Balanced Coverage (Moderate Risk)

- **Focus:** Spreading bets across both low-value numbers and choose perk rounds. For instance, backing the number **10** together with **Coin Flip** and **Pachinko**.
- **Objective:** To stabilize frequent smaller base-game hits with occasional entries into benefit functions.
- **Pros:** Keeps gameplay interesting and covers multiple scenarios.
- **Cons:** Requires cautious stake management to ensure wins surpass total wagers per spin.

Essential Tips for Responsible Play
