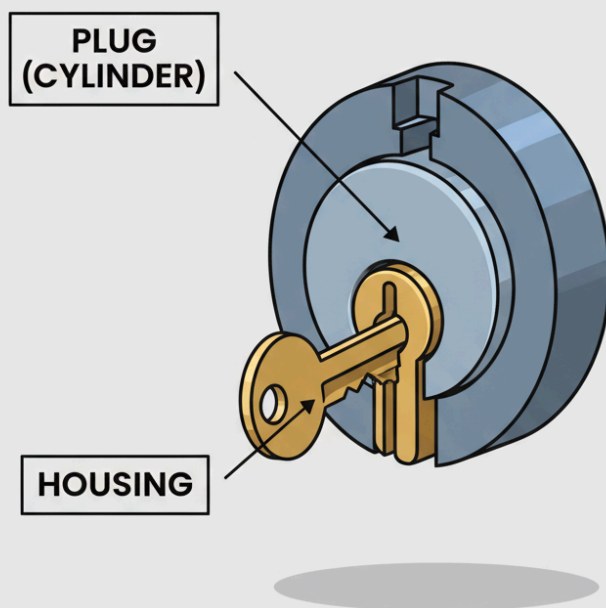
What 24/7 dispatch changes
