The Connection

The team recommends producing a pre-gathering community where participants are able to link with each other before the event. This may be a private Facebook group, a LinkedIn group, a WhatsApp group, or a devoted gathering application. Encourage attendees to introduce themselves, share their goals for the event, and start conversations. When attendees feel an impression of community before the event, they are more committed in showing up and taking part.

Beyond the Silence

Kollysphere recommends sending teasers and sneak peeks in the lead-up to your gathering. This might encompass a sneak peek of the venue, a feature on a keynote orator, a preview of a new product, or a behind-the-scenes look at the preparation process.
