On Iwo Jima, the Marine Corps fought for five weeks to seize a volcanic rock that controlled air routes to Japan. Mount Suribachi's summit observed two flags raised. The graphic made it into textbooks. The expenses went to mothers. American forces suffered approximately 26,000 casualties on Iwo Jima, which includes more or less 6,800 killed.
