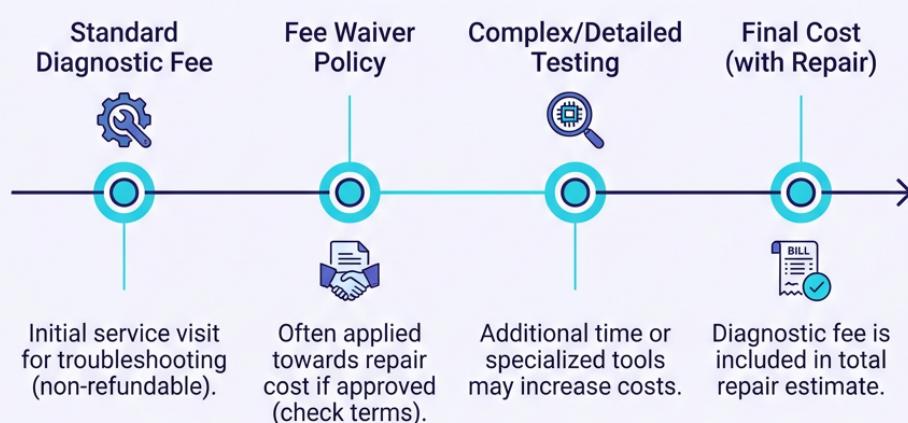
How Do Repair Hours Compare When You Calculate Lifetime Running Costs?

Most appliance repairs take between one and three hours, meaning your total labor cost typically falls between \$100 and \$450, depending on the appliance and complexity.
