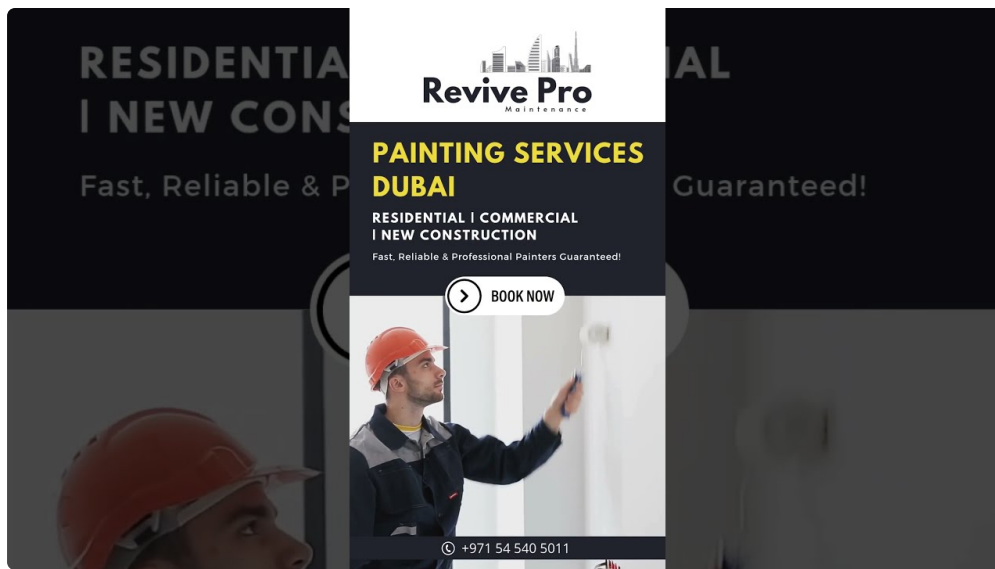

We look at various rinse water for readability on a fingertip, and we rub a white rag along a panel to determine if any chalk transfers. If it does, we wash again. Timing, weather, and moisture be counted more than such a lot of us think

Clean isn't very ample. The floor have to also be dry to the middle. On picket, we look for moisture content to fall under 15 % earlier priming.
