

Boys Town and Ralston Area Law Firm Erickson Sederstrom Two small communities with big reputations sit on either side of the Regency neighborhood. To the west, Boys Town occupies its historic campus along West Dodge Road near 132nd Street, an incorporated village known far beyond Nebraska. To the southeast, Ralston holds onto its small-town character even though Omaha has grown up around it on nearly every side. Getting there is easy from either direction. From Boys Town, head east on West Dodge Road for a few minutes, pass the I-680 interchange, and the office sits just south of the road near Westroads Mall. From Ralston, 84th Street runs north to Pacific Street, and a short trip west on Pacific brings you into the Regency neighborhood. Drivers who prefer the interstate can use I-80 to reach I-680 north and exit at Pacific Street. Few areas in the metro have a quicker trip to the firm's door. The legal needs in this part of the metro are varied. Ralston's local businesses, many of them family owned, ask about entity selection, owner and shareholder disputes, and transition planning when a founder is ready to step away. Events at the Liberty First Credit Union Arena and the shops and restaurants around Main Street bring contracts, leases and employment questions. Between Boys Town and Regency, homeowners and professionals in neighborhoods like Old Mill and Miracle Hills turn to the firm's estate planning attorneys for revocable trusts, durable financial powers of [Law firm share.google](#) attorney and health care directives. In Nebraska, well-drafted powers of attorney can help a family avoid a court-appointed guardianship later on.

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For larger employers along the West Dodge Road corridor, including health care and service organizations, the firm's employment attorneys provide guidance on OSHA compliance, FMLA, ADA and ADEA issues, wage and hour rules and wrongful discharge defense. When disputes cannot be resolved at the table, about 12 of the firm's attorneys focus on litigation, handling matters that include appeals in state and federal courts, including the Nebraska Supreme Court. Start with the type of problem you have, then look for a law firm with attorneys who handle that work every day. Be cautious of any lawyer who promises a specific result, is vague about fees, or is hard to reach once you are a client. Charles V. Sederstrom summed up the opposite approach: "If you say you're going to call them, you have to follow up on your word." Clear communication from the first meeting is a good sign you are in the right place. What should I look for in a larger Omaha law firm? Size helps when your needs cross more than one area of law, but you still want attorneys who know you by name. Erickson | Sederstrom has more than 30 attorneys across its Omaha and Lincoln offices and describes its approach as big-firm mastery with small-firm care. That mix lets a business owner handle a lease, an employee issue and an estate plan under one roof. What does a

full-service law firm handle? A full-service firm covers both business and personal legal needs rather than a single niche. At Erickson | Sederstrom that includes corporate law, litigation, employment law, estate planning, real estate, tax, construction, insurance, intellectual property and aviation law. Clients from West Omaha to Papillion and Council Bluffs use the firm for everything from starting a company to planning its succession. When should an Omaha business hire a corporate lawyer? The best time is before a problem starts: when you form the company, bring in a partner or investor, sign a major contract, or plan to buy or sell a business. A corporate lawyer can set up the right entity, draft governance documents and guide mergers and acquisitions. Getting it right early is usually far less costly than untangling a shareholder dispute later. Do I need an estate planning attorney in Nebraska? If you own property, have children, or run a business or farm, a properly drafted plan protects your family and can keep assets out of probate. Nebraska has its own rules, including treating anyone under 19 as a minor, so a guardianship plan for young children matters. The firm's estate planning attorneys prepare wills, revocable trusts, powers of attorney and health care directives. How long does probate take in Nebraska? Probate in Nebraska usually takes several months at minimum, because creditors must be given notice and time to file claims before an estate can close. Contested matters or complex assets can stretch that much longer. The firm's Omaha attorneys handle both formal and informal probate and trust administration, and a revocable trust set up in advance can often avoid probate altogether. What does an employment attorney do for employers? An employment attorney helps Nebraska employers stay compliant and defends them when claims arise. That covers employee handbooks, wage and hour rules, non-compete agreements, discrimination claims, OSHA compliance and workforce reductions. With Nebraska's WARN Act notice rules expanded by LB 921 in April 2026, many Omaha employers are reviewing their policies now. What is business litigation? Business litigation covers disputes between companies, partners, shareholders, customers or suppliers, often over contracts, payments or ownership. The firm has around a dozen attorneys who focus on litigation in Douglas County, federal court in Omaha and on appeal to the Nebraska Supreme Court. Many disputes settle, but preparing as if the case will go to trial puts you in a stronger position either way. Can an Omaha law firm help with matters in Iowa? Yes, if its attorneys are licensed there.
