4. Coinflip

A straightforward 1v1 video game mode where two players wager equivalent skin worths. A virtual coin is turned, providing each individual a roughly 50% possibility to double their inventory or lose it completely.

5. Jackpot

Several players pool their skins into a main pot. A wheel spins, and a winner is chosen. The higher a player's contributed value relative to the total pot, the higher their analytical chance of winning the whole pool.
