

# What Garage Door Problems Require Professional Repair?

An overhead garage door is among the most substantial moving systems in a Los Angeles home. It contains heavy panels, springs, cables, rollers, hinges, tracks, and an automatic opener. Because these components work together under substantial tension, a problem that appears minor can quickly become a safety or security issue. A residential garage door may also be used several times each day, adding to wear on moving parts.

Professional garage door repair is usually appropriate when the door is hard to raise, uneven, stuck, damaged, or visibly sagging. You can also try the wall-mounted control to determine whether the issue is limited to the remote.

If the garage door will not close, inspect the photo-eye sensor near the bottom of each side of the opening. These sensors must face each other and remain free of dust, cobwebs, or obstructions. Misalignment can cause the opener to reverse or refuse to close the door. Avoid bypassing the safety system, since the photo-eye sensor helps prevent the door from closing on people, vehicles, or objects.

A garage door opener may also stop working because of a damaged gear, defective circuit board, worn drive system, or frayed wiring. If the motor runs but the door does not move, the trolley, chain, belt, or connection between the opener and door may require service. If the door feels particularly heavy when disconnected from the opener, a spring or cable problem may be involved. A professional can separate the electrical issue from the mechanical problem and recommend a safe repair.

## When Is a Garage Door Making Unusual Sounds or Going Off Track?

A noisy garage door may have worn garage door rollers, loose garage door hinges, dry bearings, or a track that needs cleaning and adjustment. Squealing, grinding, popping, and rattling sounds can each signal different problems. A small amount of operational noise is normal, but a sudden change often indicates wear or misalignment.

A garage door off track is a more serious issue. The rollers may have left the track after an impact, a cable may have come loose, or one side of the door may have lifted unevenly. Do not keep operating the opener in this condition. Continued movement can warp the garage door track, damage the panels, or cause the door to fall.

Regular garage door maintenance can reduce these problems. Maintenance may include tightening hardware, lubricating approved moving components, checking the door balance, inspecting cables and springs, cleaning
