We back-brushed two coats of a satin acrylic at the body and used a a little cut back sheen at the crown details to preserve glare down lower than the afternoon sun.

The home owner informed me later that the handiest funds spent became no longer the paint logo however the time budgeted for caulking and see-priming at elevation. Four years on, a quickly consult with for typhoon contact-americaconfirmed tight joints and constant sheen, precisely what you prefer to see on a tall exterior.
