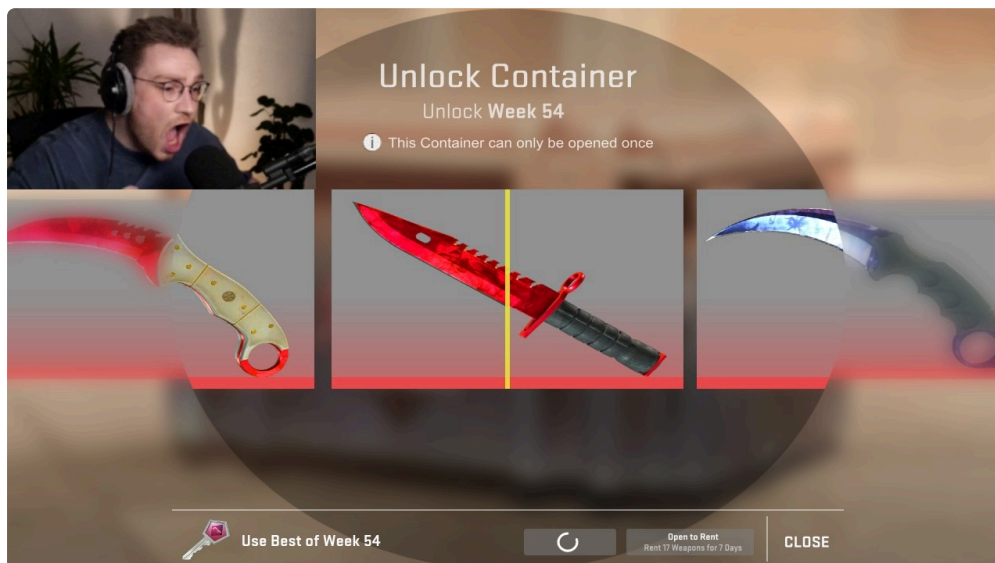

### The Rarity System

3. **Trade-Up Contracts**-- By integrating 10 products of the exact same rarity (omitting knives), players can get a single item of the next rarity tier. This system is popular for approaching higher-value skins.
4. **Battle-Pass or Operation Rewards**-- Certain operations (e.g., "Operation Broken Fang") award special skins upon completing objectives.
5. **Direct Purchase from Other Players**-- Using Steam's trade-offer system, players can buy or offer skins directly, typically at negotiated rates.

## Comprehending the Skin Economy

The skin market behaves like any other secondary market: supply, demand, and rarity drive prices. Key aspects that affect appraisal consist of:

- **Rarity & Float-- Factory New (low float) items command a premium.**
- **Pattern/Seed**-- Certain weapon patterns (e.g., "Doppler" stages) are better.
- **Sticker labels**-- Popular competition sticker labels, especially those from major events, can include substantial value.
- **Historical Events**-- Skins connected to championship groups (e.g., "Cologne" stickers) frequently appreciate after the event.

While some skins have seen returns going beyond 1,000% over a few years, the marketplace is volatile. Rates can plunge after a case release or a market adjustment wave.

## Recommended Skins by Budget
