What an authorization does not automatically tell you is your personal experience day to day. 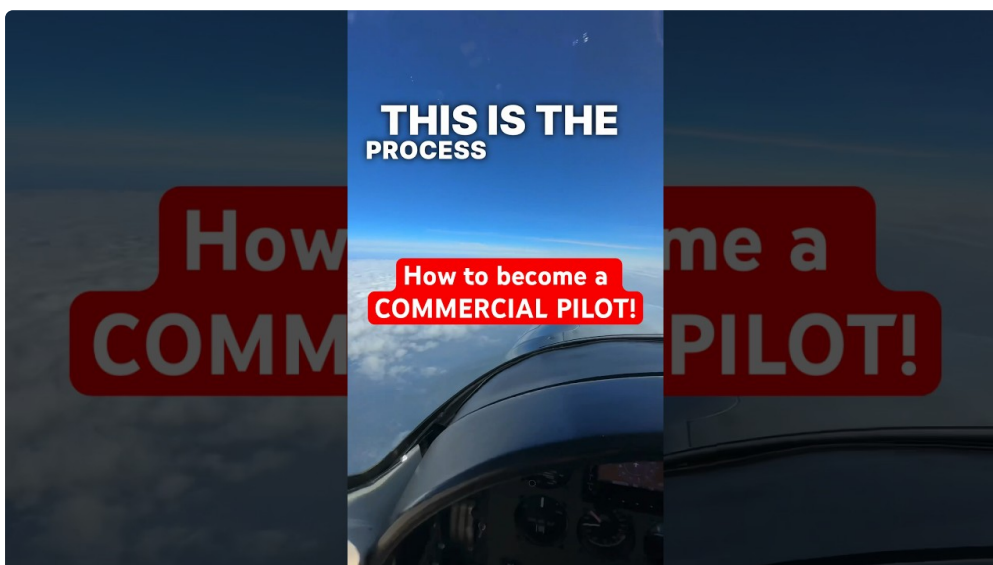
