A good locksmith visit does not end the moment the door opens, because the final check is where you find out whether the job actually solved the problem. For homes, that may mean testing the deadbolt, confirming the latch lines up, and making sure spare keys still work as expected.

That matters because some problems are symptoms of a larger wear issue, not isolated accidents. When the work is done well, the customer leaves with access restored and a better sense of what to expect if the same issue ever returns.
