

When that happens, the difference between a smooth fix and a frustrating delay often comes down to whether the locksmith can come to the house, assess the hardware on site, and handle the repair without guesswork. A good [lock change Orlando](#) depends on the condition of the cylinders, the keyway, and the surrounding door hardware. If the door is already misaligned, rekeying alone will not cure a latch that sticks.

In residential work, small problems like loose screws, weak springs, worn keys, or a rough cylinder can sometimes be corrected without changing the entire lock. The judgment call matters, because a repair that buys another year or two can be a smart choice, while a repair on a badly degraded lock can become a repeat bill.

What changes when keys are no longer the whole story

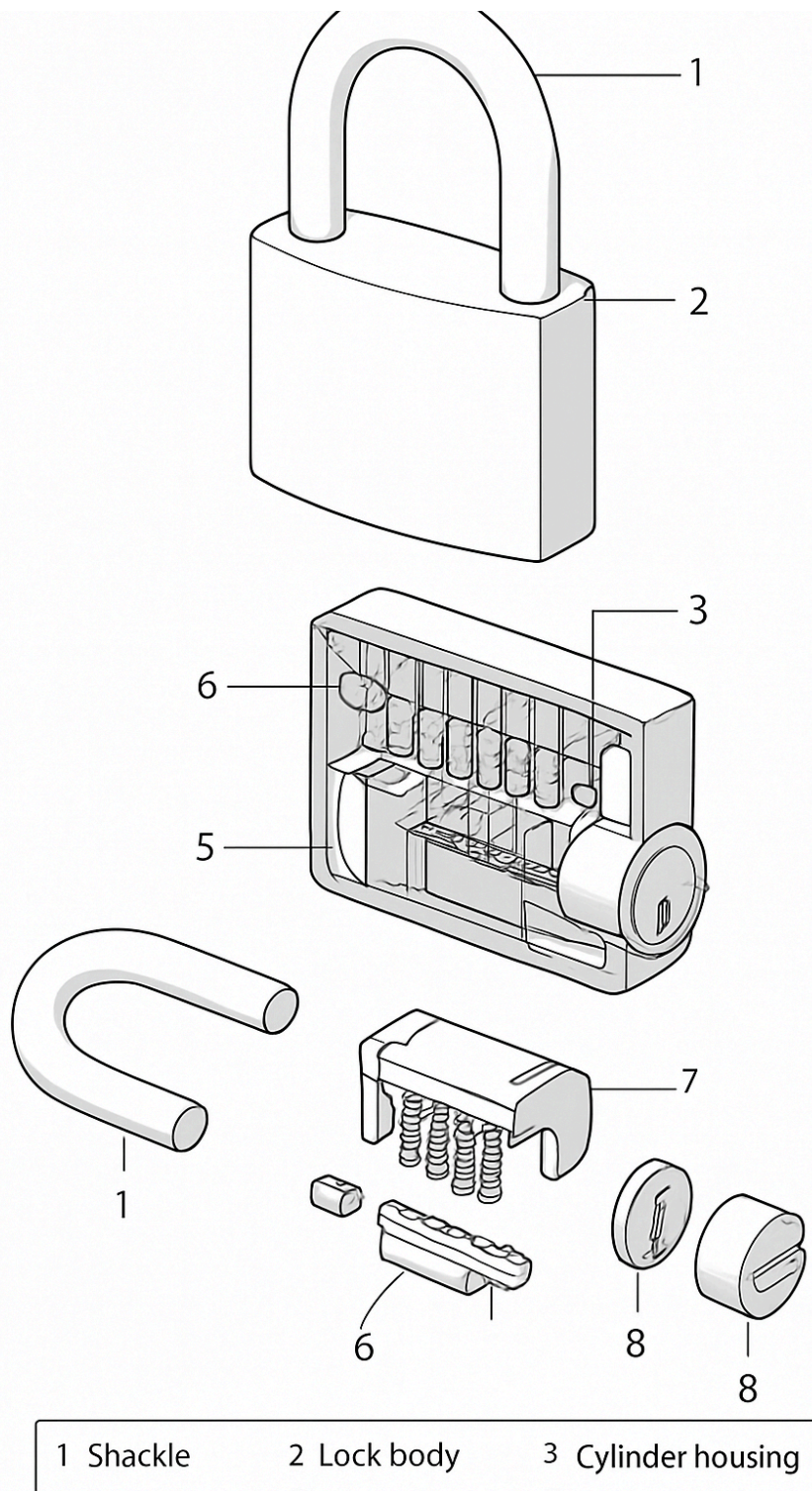
