1. Coin Flip

- **Frequency:** 4 segments on the wheel.

2. Pachinko

- **Frequency:** 2 sectors on the wheel.

3. Money Hunt

- **Frequency:** 2 sectors on the wheel.
- **How it works:** This is a shooting gallery-style reward round. A giant screen displays 108 random multipliers hidden behind different carnival signs (such as a cactus, a target, or a chef's hat). Players utilize an on-screen crosshair to intend and contend one sign before a countdown timer expires. Once the timer ends, all symbols reveal their surprise multipliers.

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** 1 segment on the wheel.
- **How it works:** The supreme bonus offer round. The host opens a red door leading into a dynamic, surreal virtual world featuring an enormous 64-segment wheel. Gamers must select one of 3 flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel is spun, and whatever multiplier the chosen flapper points to is granted. Like Pachinko, this wheel consists of "Double" and "Triple" sections, which can push multipliers as much as a staggering 20,000 x.

Popular Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

- **The Safe/Conservative Strategy:**

- *Focus:* Betting mostly on numbers 1 and 2, with periodic little cover bets on benefit rounds.
- *Objective:* To lengthen gameplay and minimize quick bankroll depletion, counting on frequent little wins.

- **The Bonus Hunter Strategy:**

- *Focus:* Placing bets solely on the four bonus rounds (Coin Flip, Pachinko, Cash Hunt, and Crazy Time).
- *Objective:* To skip the lower-paying base game numbers entirely and go after the enormous multipliers found only in the benefit features. This needs a bigger bankroll to sustain dry spells between perk hits.

- **The Balanced Approach:**

- *Focus:* Spreading bets across both numbers and bonus sections.
