The town's history go back to the Iberian period, and its strategic location made it a vital settlement for numerous civilizations, consisting of the Moors and Christians. This remarkable inland city combines UNESCO Globe Heritage sites, ancient Moorish style, and modern-day Spanish life in a way that feels totally genuine. The community's famous multicoloured homes along the seafront are just one of the Costa Blanca's most photographed places. Torrevieja provides a various side of the Costa Blanca-- it's primarily a hotel town with a large international expat area, popular for its pink salt lakes and magnificent marina. Boats leave every hour from Benidorm port, and the 20-minute trip supplies bird's-eye views of the city's well-known sky line from the water. Explore the fishing district or hike through Montgó Natural Park. Stroll along the renowned boulevard or explore the old Santa Cruz area.
