Classified (Pink)	~ 3%
Covert (Red)	~ 0.6%
Rare Special Item (Gold)	~ 0.2%

- **Avoid "Key Gambling" Sites**-- While external gaming sites exist, many operate in legal gray zones and can breach Steam's Terms of Service. Stick to official channels for safety.

- **Consider Trading Instead of Opening**-- If you're after a particular skin, purchasing it directly from the marketplace can be cheaper than purchasing secrets and wishing for a fortunate drop.
- **Stay Informed About Market Trends**-- Prices for unusual skins can escalate after a case is retired. Watching on market cycles can help you time purchases.

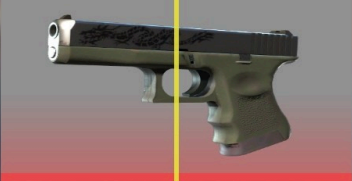
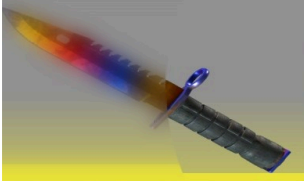
