4. Update

A mechanic unique to skin gambling websites.



- **How it works:** A player selects a skin from their stock that they want to trade up, selects a target skin of greater value, and spins a wheel. The wheel's success zone shrinks or grows depending upon the mathematical difference between the 2 products' worths.

Benefits and drawbacks of CS2 Gambling Platforms

While these websites offer entertainment and the thrill of prospective profit, they run in a legal and ethical gray area.
