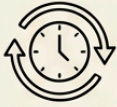
Here's the key: once you know the repair cost, you can calculate the repair-to-replacement ratio. Appliance lifespans vary widely—refrigerators typically last 10 to 15 years, washers 10 to 14 years, dryers 10 to 13 years—but age alone doesn't determine whether repair makes sense. If a five-year-old refrigerator needs a \$400 compressor repair, that's often wise. If a thirteen-year-old refrigerator needs the same repair, you may be throwing good money after a failing unit. 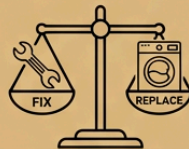
