

While most mouth ulcers resolve on their own, severe or persistent ulcers accompanied by significant pain can be assessed at Whites Dental Marble Arch as part of urgent dental care. Ulcers that last longer than two weeks, are unusually large, or [emergency dentist near me](#) are accompanied by other symptoms should be examined by a dentist to rule out more serious underlying causes. The practice's dentists can advise on pain management for severe ulcers while investigating whether further treatment or referral is needed.
