Start with how you operate the room

Every residing room has its choreography. Maybe you work from the sofa two days per week. Maybe your kids build Lego cities on the espresso table each afternoon. Maybe you host film nights and want a place for a soundbar, a small amp, and a basket of blankets. Anchoring your design to these exercises keeps the shelving reasonable.

I want to map the room in two passes. First, a birds-eye comic strip with measured partitions, windows, radiators, shops, vents, and the swing of any doors. Second, a list of what wants a home: books, vinyl, a router, game consoles, framed images, plants, a cordless vacuum, firewood. Assigning real amounts allows.
