We sanded profiles with foam pads and shot two topcoats of satin urethane. Doors had been sprayed flat in the store with the comparable device. Hardware holes have been crammed and re-drilled to exchange from 3-inch pulls to 5-inch, which required a jig and persistence to avert strains immediately.

From arrival to final wipe-down took eight operating days. At day 3 after rehang, the end felt dry but we nonetheless cautioned comfortable use for a couple of weeks. Six months later the purchaser often called, no longer with a criticism, but to agenda ceiling portray products and services in the adjacent relatives room considering the cupboards made the previous ceiling seem to be tired. That is the ripple outcomes a good-accomplished cupboard end has on a house.
