In a moist week, a freshly washed aspect may desire forty eight hours to come down to a nontoxic proportion. Rushing primer onto damp siding traps moisture, which attempts to escape later, pushing the movie off as blisters.

Temperature, dew factor, and wind speed all outcome a paint film. Most outside acrylics like ambient temperatures among 50 and ninety stages, surface temperatures inside of a few ranges of ambient, and falling humidity. If the dew factor sits within 5 levels of the surface temp at nightfall, predict condensation, which will spot or streak a refreshing coat.
