

A reliable garage door safeguards vehicles, tools, storage, and entry into your home. In Los Angeles, a failure may be caused by normal wear, dust, heat, moisture, corrosion, impact damage, or an aging opener. Recognizing the likely problem, safety risks, and cost drivers helps you approve necessary work without paying for repairs you do not need.

## What Garage Door Problems Call for Professional Repair?

An **overhead garage door** is a balanced system that consists of panels, tracks, rollers, cables, springs, hinges, and an electric opener. A failure in one component can put unusual stress on the others. Professional garage door repair is necessary when the door is heavy, crooked, stuck, loud, or unsafe to move manually.

Common issues involve a broken **garage door spring**, a frayed **garage door cable**, bent track, damaged rollers, loose hinges, worn bearings, and a malfunctioning **garage door opener**. Some problems are minor adjustments, while others require professional tools and precise tension control. Homeowners should not attempt to remove or adjust a loaded spring because it can release dangerous force.

## Why Is My Garage Door Not Opening or Closing?

A tripped breaker, unplugged unit, failed wall button, dead remote control battery, or disconnected trolley can stop operation. If the opener runs but the door does not move, the drive gear, carriage, or spring system may need expert diagnosis.

If the **garage door will not close**, inspect the **photo-eye sensor** near the bottom of each side of the opening. The sensors must face one another and remain free of dust, cobwebs, or obstructions. Bright sunlight, loose wiring, or a misaligned sensor can also interrupt the safety circuit. Do not permanently bypass this feature.

A damaged **garage door track** can cause binding, scraping, or a door that reverses. A professional can assess whether the track needs adjustment, fastening, or replacement. Avoid forcing the door or repeatedly activating the opener, since doing so may damage cables, rollers, or the motor.

## When Is a Noisy or Uneven Door a Safety Concern?

Some operating noise is normal, but grinding, popping, snapping, or loud vibration deserves attention.
