For a Twenties Craftsman, the purchaser feared that a bold door would struggle the original stained trim inside of. We mocked up a deep auburn, a bottle green, and a troublesome brown with a pink undertone. The bottle eco-friendly received out of doors, but we painted the within face a warm off-black that matched the dwelling room's steel fireside display. The break up-face technique, efficient open air and close to-black interior, saved the architecture cohesive in equally recommendations.
