

What Does Garage Door Repair Generally Include?

Garage door repair includes the inspection, adjustment, repair, or replacement of the parts that allow an overhead garage door to move safely. A garage door technician may service the door itself, the lifting system, the tracks, the opener, and the safety devices.

A typical service appointment may include examining the door balance, adjusting loose hardware, lubricating moving parts, adjusting the track, replacing worn garage door rollers, repairing garage door cables, and testing the opener. What Is the Cost of Replacing a Two-Car Garage Door?

A door that starts moving and reverses may have an obstruction, incorrect travel limits, a broken spring, excessive resistance, or a failing opener.
