

Walk the delivery hallway of any busy center in Joliet and you will certainly hear it, the constant rhythm of slats rolling up, forklifts moving via, and alarms being examined at shift modification. Those roll-up steel doors are greater than a comfort. - Annual decline screening and documentation, usually verified throughout regular fire assessments by the City of Joliet Structure Division or the fire department.

- A guv that controls descent. If it slams, it is wrong. If it sneaks down gradually and catches at half height, likewise wrong. The reset must be trained, documented, and very easy enough that your upkeep tech can do it after a test.

During garage door installment work in a food center outside Joliet, the opening sat over a slope that fooled the eye. The door looked square, but the flooring went down nearly an inch from left to right. We changed overview footwear and established the lower bar to seal against the high side, then installed a conical smoke seal. ## **Ratings, smoke control, and why labels matter**

The hour rating is not a guess. A listed door assembly will have a permanent tag suggesting the score, the examination requirement, and the listing agency. 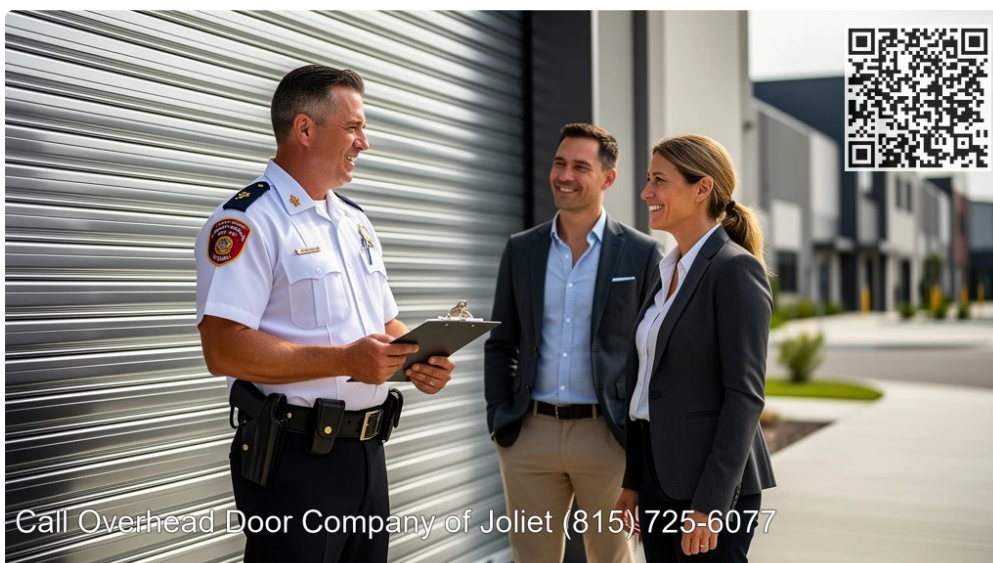

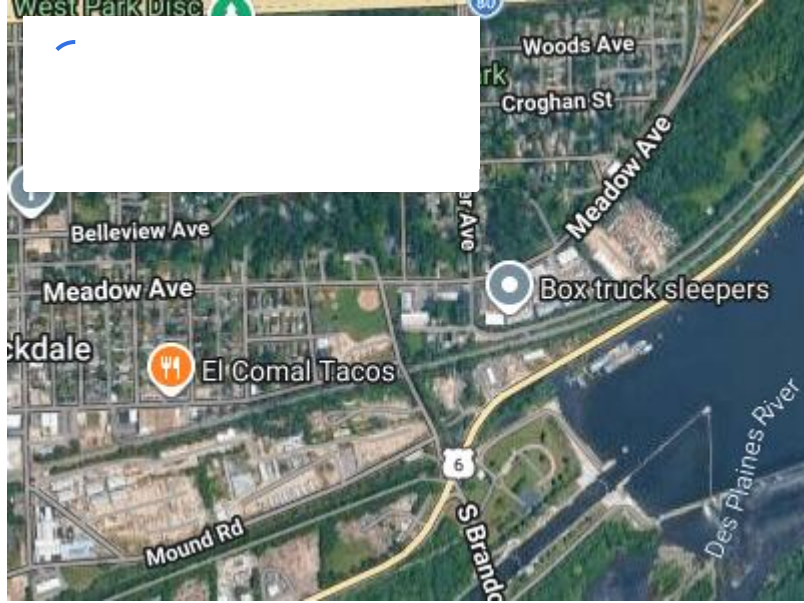
