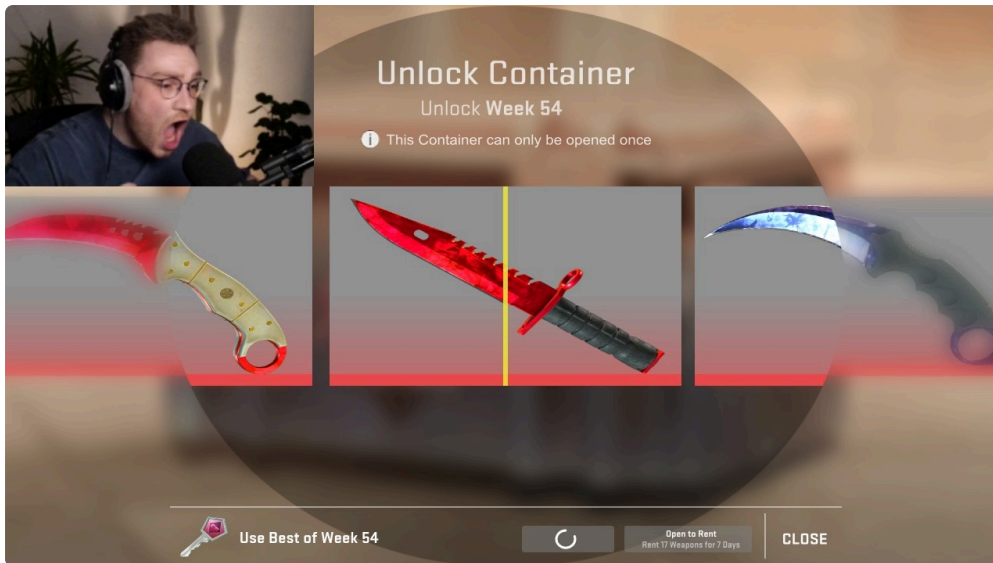
Item Rarity	Approximate Drop Rate
Mil-Spec (Blue)	~ 80%
Restricted (Purple)	~ 15%
Classified (Pink)	~ 4%
Covert (Red)	~ 0.65%
Rare Special Item (Knife)	~ 0.26%

*Note: The exact probability for a specific knife (e.g., Karambit|Fade) is a portion of the unusual special item swimming pool.*

These numbers illustrate that the frustrating bulk of openings will produce basic skins, not knives. The low probability makes knife openings a high-risk, high-reward activity.

# Popular Knife Types and Market Values
