- By viewing the competition live via the Steam TV or in-game customer, or by taking part in the Pick 'Em Challenge using a Viewer Pass, players can earn Souvenir Cases specific to that tournament.
- These cases do not need a crucial to open, making them 100% complimentary value when obtained.
