Mistakes theoretically do not remain theoretical. They become poor routines later on, and they cost even more initiative to deal with once you are hectic with flight sessions.

So when you listen to that 19 students began in March 2026 and began the academic phase, that is the point where the training clock starts to operate on deepness, not vibes.

AELO's 2 major pathways, and what they imply for expectations

AELO's public-facing products describe two major training paths.

One is an 18-month ATPL Integrated Program.

The various other is the SkyAlps Airlines MPL Program, called a path with a task warranty or positioning route.
