Why the first response matters

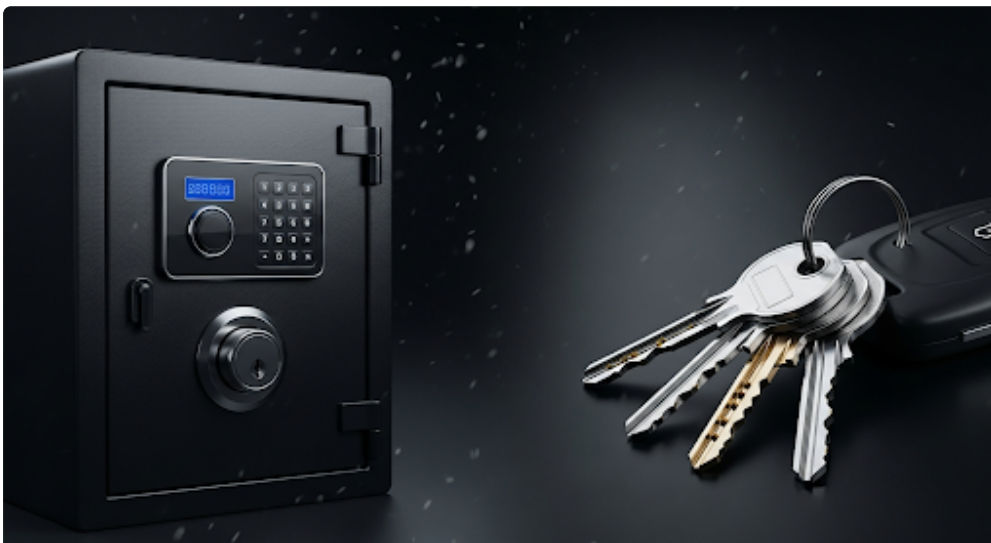
