In a downtown loft with concrete flooring and steel windows, the owners desired the kitchen to behave like component to the residing location. We used a skinny porcelain slab with a gentle limestone print, mitered to study as a two-inch aspect. The backsplash ran complete top, shops moved to the underside of the higher shelves, and the island had no overhang at the window facet, so it examine like a monolith rather than a bar. When you sat at the couch, the counters reflected just sufficient easy to lift the room with out pulling consciousness from the artwork wall.

A family members dwelling with 3 institution-age children and a severe cook considered necessary sturdiness certainly. Perimeter counters went to leathered black granite. The island became Taj Mahal quartzite in a honed conclude, which paired with white oak cupboards and helped bridge the nice and cozy-cool hole among the dwelling room rug and the immaculate selection. We deliberate seam placement after templating, aligning the faint quartzite veins with the cupboard rails. Three years later, the surfaces still glance sparkling, and the occasional nick at the granite aspect buffs out with a diamond pad.

Budget, value, and where to spend
