We used breadboard ends, a tongue at the panel captured with the aid of a groove ultimately caps with pegs in elongated holes. The heart tenon got a good pin, the outer tenons got slotted pins. The tops stayed flat through 3 summers and two winters, and the paint traces did now not crack.

In a domicile place of business equipped-ins challenge with inset doors, the secret became the face frame joinery. The stiles and rails met with unfastened tenons at each and every nook and mid-rail. That kept the frame sq. and steady so the doors fit like a glove with a 1/16 inch monitor.
