A keep insisted on pink letters over a mid-tone eco-friendly fascia to event a vacation campaign. Red on green compresses comparison for plenty of audience. We supplied two mockups at scale, one with crimson face lit letters over a deeper green panel, and one with white letters and a purple accessory bar. The workforce chose the white letters.
