

Medford sits in that part of Suffolk County that still feels lived-in rather than polished for show. It has the mix people tend to like once they spend time here, wooded residential streets, busy commercial corridors, older properties with character, and enough open space nearby to remind you that Long Island still has roots under the pavement.
